He has made everything beautiful in its time. Ecclesiastes 3:11 NIV

Read Scripture; Matthew 13: 1-9 RSV

- 1. That same day Jesus went out of the house and sat beside the sea. 2. And great crowds gathered about him, so that he got into a boat and sat there; and the whole crowd stood on the beach.
- 3. And he told them many things in parables, saying: "A sower went out to sow, 4. And as he sowed, some seeds fell along the path, and the birds came and devoured them. 5. Other seeds fell on rocky ground, where they had not much soil, and immediately they sprang up, since they had no depth of soil, 6. but when the sun rose they were scorched; and since they had no root they withered away. 7. Other seeds fell upon thorns, and the thorns grew up and choked them. 8. Other seeds fell upon good soil and brought forth grain, some a hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty.
- 9. He who has ears, let him hear."

Matthew 13: 18-23

18. Hear then the parable of the sower. 19. When anyone hears the word of the kingdom and does not understand it, the evil one comes and snatches away what is sown in his heart; this is what was sown along the path. 20. As for what was sown on rocky ground, this is he who hears the word and immediately receives it with joy; 21. yet he has no root in himself, but endures for a while, and when tribulation and persecution arises on account of the word, immediately he falls away. 22. As for what was sown among thorns, this is he who hears the word, but the cares of the world and the delight in riches choke the word, and it proves unfruitful. 23. As for what was sown on good soil, this is he who hears the word and understands it; he indeed bears fruit, and yields, in one case a hundredfold, in another sixty, and in another thirty."

Message:

Some things to think about.... As you read this parable, does it make you think of some folks you know, or may have met casually? Are they on the path of the road where they can be misled or distracted by others, or their time is 'gobbled up' by meaningless things because they have no depth? Or, are they followers for a short time, and soon are withered away from the Word?

Where can you find yourself? Can you see yourself on the good soil ... bearing fruit? Our congregation nurtures each other. We hear the Word, do our best to care for each other in many ways, and follow God's path, being strong in our faith. There may be times when we falter, but we are rooted in His message! Let anyone with ears, listen.

Think on these thoughts. Be strong in your faith.

Trust and love each other. Share the Love!

Be kind to all you encounter and let them see His Spirit in YOU!

Pray together:

As our prayers wash over the sandy shore, our prayers come to you, oh Lord! We ask for your comfort for those hurting from discrimination of any kind. Sing to us through your birds, and reassure us that All your people matter! Heal our hearts from pain, both physical and emotional. Heal and comfort us, Lord. Be with us in our silent prayers...
